
December Extended sign-ups will be posted on Monday, Nov.26. It's a short month and one you won't want to miss out on! It will give you stress-free shopping or rest time!

PLAY & FEAST FACTS: 11:00-1:00

• Please remember to <u>sign up</u> for the Feast. The Parent Committee will offer Sign-up Genius. We ask that EVERY family donates to this special Feast.





- Food that you are bringing to share. (Main dish, side dish or dessert) Allergy alert: no nuts in any dishes, please.
- Number attending. (Due to lack of space, we can only accommodate 3 total (student included. All younger siblings are welcome.) for the meal in in the Worship and Fireside Rooms.
- The Play will be performed in our historical Meetinghouse. We have plenty of room for ALL to attend the Play. So, feel free to invite family and/or friends. We would like for the parents/siblings to have seating priority in the Center sections. The center sections will also be reserved for parents & grandparents needing assistance. The outer boxed seating and balcony is available for extended family and friends. We will have photo opportunities for each age group after they sing. You will be invited to come forward and take close-up photos.
- There are 2 days of Plays/Feasts, Monday, Nov. 19 and Tuesday, Nov. 20
 - Check your classroom calendar for your assigned day. On your child's "feast day" they will only attend the feast activities. The day they are not participating in the feast, they will attend their regular school day, including EMD.
 - There will be NO LUNCH BUNCH OR EXTENDED SESSIONS on our feast days. (UNLESS your child is registered in Mrs. Bighinatti's afternoon Add-on classes.)
- Those registered for our Afternoon Add-on classes: please see Mrs. Bighinatti for your schedule.
- On the day of your feast, PLEASE BE PROMPT AND DROP YOUR CHILD OFF IN THEIR CLASSROOM between 10:30 and 10:45. The play begins at 11:00 sharp.

Costumes:

- 3s (Turkeys) Dress them in adorable clothing. :) They will be wearing headbands designed by their little hands.
- 4s (Native Americans) —they will be wearing a decorated larger brown T-shirt

over their clothing. A long-sleeved shirt and dark pants or leggings would look great.

5s AM & 4s/5s PM (Pilgrims) — the boys will have black capes and hats provided. Dark pants and white or light shirts would look nice. The girls will have burgundy skirts with muslin aprons and bonnets that are provided.
 A long-sleeved top and leggings would be comfortable and look nice for the play.
